## *From the President's Desk* *Mr. Jeff Lin*

*This July, we celebrate the 20th anniversary of SBDMC, Inc. We are commemorating this very special milestone thanks to the supreme vision and hard work of our board of directors and employees, past and present, and the support and cooperation of the Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) and Subic Bay Gateway Park (SBGP) locators.*

*SBGP, also known as Subic Bay Industrial Park, was one of the first major projects inside the Subic Bay Freeport Zone (SBFZ). It also represented a partnership between the governments of the Philippines and Republic of China (R.O.C.) Taiwan. The Taiwan government was among the first to believe in the potential of Subic Bay as an alternative site for investment following the withdrawal of the U.S. Navy in 1992. By July 3, 1994, SBDMC, Inc., the developer and administrator of SBGP, held its opening ceremony with then Taiwan Minister of Economic Affairs P.K. Chiang and SBMA Chairman Richard J. Gordon as guests of honor. Subic Bay benefited from the Taiwan government's Go South policy as the first locators in SBGP are Taiwanese companies. The Go South policy encouraged domestic businesses to invest in Southeast Asia including the Philippines in the 1990s. The pioneer locators were led by Acer, Inc. (now Wistron), which opened its biggest and most modern computer plant outside Taiwan inside a 15-hectare land in (share) in December 1997. In 1998, Trianon (SGLife) and its 9 suppliers became the first locators in Phase II. Other locators followed including P.O. Mizuno, Jeng Chang, Naigano Toyook, Center, Sanlin, Genetec, Anglo Ana, D2 Aerospace, Hitech (MSA), Fujiann, Etron, Sanyo Denki, etc.*

*Twenty years later, SBGP counts 244 companies of various nationalities as locators providing employment to around 11,100 workers. Aside from manufacturing companies, SBGP is now home to the Subic Bay Exhibition and Convention Center (SBCEC), Manobo Skills Development Center, MCOM Commercial Building and other commercial firms such as Ford, Mitsubishi and KK Hotel (all center (S4 Corp.) and trading companies. More importantly, we are proud that SBGP has contributed to the economic development of Subic Bay and improvement of the lives of the people in the neighboring provinces through millions in investments made by locators and employment generated. Now, as we enter our 20th year, we are happy to welcome our newest locator, Mabuhay Interflour BOK, Inc., which will invest an estimated US\$30 million for its Philippine flour mill operation. We are also set to welcome another big potential locator, Philward Industrial Corp, which will engage in the manufacturing of pre-painted steel coils and metal sheets for export and domestic trade and other allied industries with an investment of US\$ 200 million.*

*It has truly been a challenging albeit rewarding twenty years. SBDMC saw buildings rise one by one in the previous years and completely weathered the effects of the 1997-1998 Asian financial crisis. As we look back at how far we have come and appreciate where we are now, we have no doubt that this is just the beginning and the best is yet to come. Certainly, we will and should pursue for another 20 golden years for SBGP and SBDMC to bring forth better commitment to our valued SBGP locators. And so we would like to take this opportunity to sincerely appreciate all those who have been a part of our journey. Thanks to all of you and congratulations to all of us!*

## SBMA, Singapore's Interflour Group close \$30-M investment deal



**SUBIC BAY FREEPORT** - Singapore-based Interflour Group Pte Ltd. (Interflour), one of the producers of the finest flour in the world, will be building its Philippine mill in Subic as part of its expansion program to meet flour demand in Southeast Asia.

This developed as Interflour Managing Director and Chief Executive Greg Harvey, Subic Bay Gateway Park President Jeff Lin, and Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) Chairman Roberto Garcia signed a 50-year lease contract on June 26, 2014 paving the way for the construction of the flour mill facility.

The event was witnessed by SBMA DCC Jover Reyes, SBMA Deputy Administrator Joy Alvarado and SBMA Investment Manager Ronnie Yambao. Representing Interflour were Group COO Jack Joseph, Group Marketing Director Angel Umali, Group CFO Ma. Cristina Piguino, Group General Counsel Mark Neo, Maculoy Interflour Mill Inc. (MIMI) Board Members Jesus Alvarado and Edgardo Gallo, and MIMI General Manager Vicente Magbanua.

Registered under the business name Mabuhay Interflour Mill Inc. the new flour mill is part of the US\$30-million committed project investment of Interflour in Subic.

Garcia said the new Subic entrant is proof that the Philippines is "in the screen" of foreign investors who are encouraged by the trust and confidence earned by President Aquino's good governance program.

The new flour mill will be constructed in a 52,552-sq.m. lot inside the Subic Bay Gateway Park. It is expected to be completed in 24 months' time.

The company will engage in milling of wheat into food flour for direct sale to consumers, distributors and retailers in the domestic and foreign markets. Garcia added that the project would provide bakeries and entrepreneurs in the country with the highest quality flour at competitive or much lower price as the cost of hauling and transporting flour to parts of Central and Northern Luzon will be cut by as much as fifty percent.

This will also mean additional revenue for SBMA of about P6.5 million a year, for the use of ports by transport ships coming from wheat-growing countries like Australia, United States, Canada, as well as Europe and the Black Sea countries.

For Interflour, Harvey noted that Interflour Group is one of the biggest flour milling companies in the world with seven flour mills located in Vietnam, Indonesia, Malaysia and Turkey. The combined wheat milling capacity of these mills is nearly 6,000 tons per day, which is equivalent to almost 1.5 million tons of flour produced each year.

He added that Interflour holds international certifications for its world-class technology, including Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP), and a certification for producing Halal food products.

The proposed mill in Subic will be capable of producing 500 metric tons a day of flour. However, Interflour plans to expand its capacity with an additional 500 tons by 2019.

"The Philippines is an important market in Asia, with an estimated 25,000 bakeries and with Cebu as the largest. Interflour will be offering the finest flour for the local market, particularly in Central Luzon," Harvey said. (30)


